CSFN RESOLUTION TO PRESERVE PARKS, OPEN SPACE AND GREENBELTS

Whereas. parks, open space and greenbelts are invaluable resources needed to maintain the health of San Franciscans and the beauty of the city;

Whereas, the city increasingly proposes to cut trees and construct buildings in parks, open space and greenbelts;

Whereas, construction—unrelated to park use—has been proposed and/or approved on the Marina Green, in Rincon Park, in the Transbay Terminal park, in Ferry Plaza, on the Brannan Street Wharf green space, and in Golden Gate Park;

Whereas, the city needs more park space;

Therefore, be it resolved, the Coalition for San Francisco Neighborhoods opposes the construction of buildings in city parks, greenbelts and open space and calls upon city officials to enact legislation prohibiting such construction.
