Prohibit State Limitations on Local Rent Control Initiative. *Extend mostly to corporate landlords?* Repealing the Costa-Hawkins Rental Housing Act (1995), to allow cities and counties to limit rent on any housing and limit the rent for first-time tenants and, Prohibiting the state from limiting "the right of any city, county, or city and county to maintain, enact or expand residential rent control."
